RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #2, of Bordentown Township, Burlington County in the state of New Jersey is owner of certain surplus property which is no longer needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #2, of Bordentown Township, Burlington County in the state of New Jersey are desirous of selling said surplus property in an “as is” condition without express or implied warranties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District No2, Bordentown Township, in the County of Burlington, as follows;

- (1) The sale of the surplus property shall be conducted through GovDeals pursuant to State Contract T2581 in accordance with the terms and conditions of the State Contract. The terms and conditions of the agreement entered into with GovDeals are available online at www.govdeals.com and also available from the Chief of the Department, Fire District #2, of Bordentown Township.
- (2) The sale will be conducted online and the address of the auction site is www.govdeals.com.
- (3) The sale is being conducted pursuant to Local Finance Notice 2008-9.
- (4) The surplus property to be sold is as follow;
 - 1) Bullard T3 thermal imaging camera with vehicle charger and two (2) batteries.
 - 2) Hurst/Honda JL4GSV dual outlet, gas powered, portable hydraulic pump with one (1) 25-foot hose.
 - 3) Hurst JL16 Maverick combination hydraulic tool.
 - 4) Champion “C” cutter.
 - 5) Harrington 3 to 1 siamese (2.5” NST x 5” Stortz).

- (5) The surplus property as identified shall be sold in an “as-is” condition without express or implied warranties with the successful bidder required to execute a Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement concerning use of said surplus property.
- (6) The Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #2, of Bordentown Township, Burlington County in the state of New Jersey reserves the right to accept or reject any bid submitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a signed, conformed and compared copy of this Resolution be maintained by the Board of Fire Commissioners, Fire District #2, of Bordentown Township as an official Board record pursuant to and in accordance with the “Open Public Records Act”, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq. and pursuant to and in accordance with the State of New Jersey Municipal agencies Record Retention Schedule promulgated by the Division of Archives and Record Management.
