# BTFD #2 SPECIAL MEETING BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS

## February 22, 2024

#### READING OF THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS STATEMENT:

#### REVIEW OF THE PUBLIC BIDDING REQUIREMENTS:

Caitlin Harney Norcia, Esq. Provided the following information:

- -Purchase of a new Fire Truck requires a Bond.
- -Repairs to the Fire Station Roof do not require a Bond
- -Architectural Services related to the Roof do not require a Bond.
- -Professional services such as an Architect must be obtained through an RFP process if the amount

exceeds \$17,510. Attorney will work with the Chief to obtain relavent information related to the professional services to be performed and the Solicitor shall prepare a specification for BTFD#2 Fire Commissioners approval prior to advertising. Only Professional responding to the RFP are eligible for consideration.

Commissioner Andrew Law, provided an overview of the Rural Development Bond Program administered by the the US Dept. of Agriculture that will be utilized to purchase the Fire Engine recently approved by a vote of the residents in Fire District 2. A Pre-application is required and services of a Bond Counsel will be required at an amount not to exceed \$17,510 cap. After Pre-application approval the BTFD#2 must submit a formal application to US Dept. of Agriculture. The federal funds will allow the BTFD#2 to interim finance of the building of the Fire Engine. The loan is locked in with a letter of intent from US Dept. of Agriculture. A resolution will be required authorizing designated BTFD#2 Commissioners to process all federal forms.

NOTE: State Local Finance Board approval is required and the BTFD#2 Commissioners will coordinated the paperwork with the Solicitor and Bond Counsel.

As background to the recent Ballot initiative, Chair Cann discussed with the Solicitor issues related to collection of taxes related to Warehouse project in the Township. He advised that the BTFD#@ was in cont with State Legislator Herb Conaway who will be working on this issue with the NJ League of Municipalities, NJ Dept. of Community Affairs and State Legislature to find a fix. Under present legislation only the Counties and Schools reveive a benefits form Warehouse Construction resulting from local PILOT agreements. There was also some discussion that municipalities could offset some of the shortfalls through contributions not to exceed \$162,000 annually foe equipment and repairs.

Chief, MacFarland reminded the BTFD#2 Commissioners that he would be on sick leave most of the following week.

## MEETING OPENED TO THE PUBLIC:

At 7:20 pm Chair Jim Cann requested a motion to open the meeting to the public and George Chidley made a motion to open the meeting to the public prior to budget approval and the motion was seconded by Andrew Law. All members present affirmed the motion to open the meeting for public comment.

BTFD#2 will take advantage of Cooperative Purchasing on all individual bids.
